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Parent Code of Conduct

1. Have respect for all volunteer coaches, team members, opponents, officials and other representatives involved in Portales City Sports.
2. Agree to support our team in a positive manner and showcase good sportsmanship toward all players, coaches, parents, and game officials (USA FOOTBALL p24).
3. Ensure that my child takes proper care of all equipment that is issued and/or placed at a gym or field.
4. Immediately notify a coach if equipment becomes damaged (particular attention must be given to the care of helmets and shoulder pads).
5. Immediately notify a coach if my child will be absent from practice.
6. Make sure my child is picked up on time after practices or games, or contact the coach as soon as possible if I cannot.
7. Ensure that my child knows and understands that Sportsmanship and Teamwork are mandatory; **no vulgar language, tantrums, displays of anger or fighting will be tolerated.**
8. Respect the coaches' commitment to coach my child and will not interfere with on-field instruction during practices or games (USA FOOTBALL p24).
9. Ensure that my child represents him/herself and teammates on and off the field and/or gym.
10. Teach my child to play by the rules and respect teammates, opponents, game officials, and coaches (USA FOOTBALL p24).
11. Make sure whether in victory or defeat my child conducts him/herself with pride and poise.
12. Ensure that my child knows and understands that he/she is a player for Portales City Sports and that the game is measured by the development of skills, not by winning or losing.
13. I will cheer for our team in a positive manner no matter the outcome of the game (USA FOOTBALL p24).
14. Talk to the League Coordinator, or Contact the League Director, if there is a concern.

Athlete Code of Conduct

1. Have respect for all **volunteer coaches**, team members, opponents, officials and other representatives involved in Portales City Sports; when I score a touchdown I will simply hand the ball to the official before celebrating with my teammates (USA FOOTBALL p23).
2. Take proper care of all equipment that is issued and/or placed at a gym or field.
3. I will honor the sport by playing within the rules during games and practices (USA FOOTBALL p23).
4. Immediately notify my coach if equipment becomes damaged (particular attention must be given to the care of helmets and shoulder pads. **Never sit on my helmet or any of the sports balls.**
5. Immediately notify my coach if I will be absent from practice.
6. I will remember that Sportsmanship and Teamwork are mandatory. **No vulgar language, tantrums, displays of anger, or fighting will be tolerated.**
7. I am accountable for the results of my behavior toward my teammates, coaches and game officials (USA FOOTBALL p23).
8. Represent myself and teammates on and off the field and/or gym.
9. Conduct myself with pride and poise, whether in victory or defeat.
10. When I make a great play, I will not embarrass my opponent (USA FOOTBALL p23).
11. Remember that I am a player for Portales City Sports and that the game is measured by the development of skills, not by winning or losing.
12. Agree to put my team first and put forth my best effort on the field in support of team goals.
13. Talk to the League Coordinator, or Contact the League Director, if there is a concern.

**If either "Code of Conduct" is violated, a system of disciplinary actions/steps will be followed:

1. The "Parent Code of Conduct", is your warning.
2. The first violation will result in a suspension from one game.
3. The second violation will result in and indefinite suspension and a mandatory appearance in front of the **Portales Sports Committee and Portales Recreation Advisory Board.**
